PROCUREMENT

Buy Ontario Act, 2025

APR 13 2026
IN EFFECT

- Public sector must prioritize Ontario — then Canadian — goods and services
- U.S. businesses restricted from Ontario public-sector procurement
- Applies to ministries, municipalities, hospitals, school boards, agencies
- Non-compliance: withheld funding & ministerial review
- Municipal capital infrastructure: May 15, 2026 • Local boards: June 1, 2026
